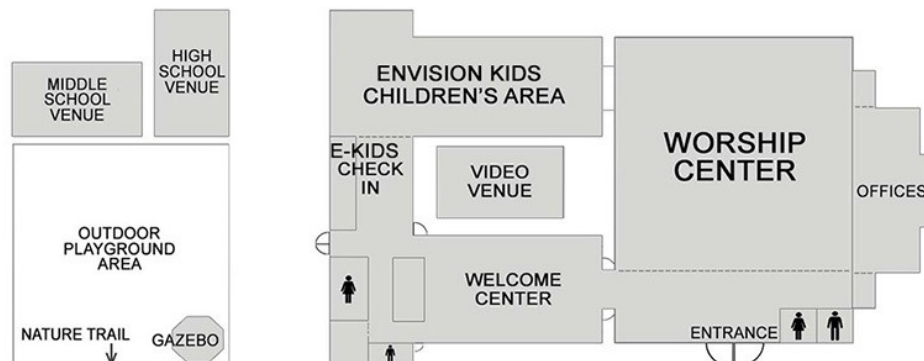

3. Be _____ to one another
