
## Got Kids?

#### **How to Invest in Healthy Relationships**

#### 1. I need to see my relationships as a gift from God

Then God said, "Let us make human beings on our image, to be like us. So, God created human beings in his own image. In the image of God he created them; male and female he created them. Then God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and multiply."

Genesis 1:26-28 NLT

And yet, O Lord, you are our Father. We are the clay, and you are the potter. We are all formed by your hand. Don't be so angry with us, Lord. Please don't remember our sins forever. Look at us, we pray, and see that we are all your people. Isaiah 64:8-9 NLT

So, you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when he adopted you as his own children. Now we call him, "Abba, Father." Romans 8:15 NLT

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16 NIV

### 2. I need to learn to let go of past hurts

Do not remember the sins of my youth and my rebellious ways; according to your love remember me, for you, Lord, are good. Psalm 25:7 NIV

ACTION STEP: With God's help, I will begin to extend the mercy I enjoy with those in my life.			
3. I need to accept things as they are, not as they used to be			
I don't mean to say that I already achieved these things or that I have already reached perfection. But I press on to possess that perfection for which Christ Jesus first possessed me. No, dear brothers and sisters, I have not achieved it, but I focus on this one thing: Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead. I press on to reach the end of the race and receive the heavenly prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us. Philippians 3:12-14 NLT			
Didn't we tell you this would happen while we were still in Egypt? We said, "Leave us alone! Let us be slaves to the Egyptians. It's better to be a slave in Egypt than a corpse in the wilderness!" But Moses told the people, "Don't be afraid. Just stand still and watch the Lord rescue you today." Exodus 14:12-13 NLT
